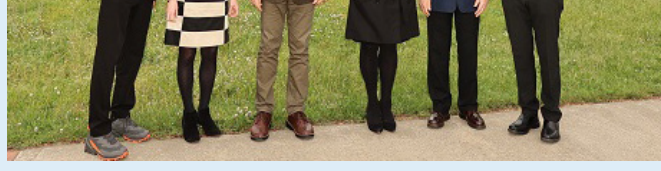
Dean's Address
