Spatial research investigates how voters' ideological and policy domains influence their vote choices, conditioned by spatial competition and how voters perceive it. Applying a novel random utility model and employing original survey and panel data, this study investigates the changes in Turkish voters' choice sets and vote choices in the 2023 elections vis-à-vis the parliamentary elections in the last decade The findings suggest that having strategically taken more polarized stands over time, Turkish political parties become more likely to be included in increasingly stronger partisans' choice sets and thus enjoy more loyal constituencies. As the first study on issue voting in Turkey and the long- and short-term effects of high and rapidly growing polarization on electoral behavior, the findings significantly contribute to the

literature on snatial theories of issue voting saliency theory
